Information for international applications (please read thoroughly!)

1.) Deadlines

International applicants who wish to begin or continue their studies at University of Graz must submit their complete application with all necessary original documents by 5 September for the winter semester and by 5 February for the summer semester of each year (date of receipt at the university).

2.) Documents

- Copy of passport/ID-card
- a. First-year students: Bachelor, Diploma, Teacher Training
- Secondary school leaving certificate with school reports from senior school
- Qualification Statement: Evidence that admission requirements to the same study programme at a recognized university in the country where the secondary school leaving certificate was obtained are fulfilled for the semester/ academic year in which admission is sought in Graz, including the general duration of this programme. (not necessary for EU/ EEA nationals)
- Transcript of records of already accomplished Courses
- b. Students continuing their studies: Master
- Evidence of accomplished Bachelor/Diploma (transcript of records/diploma supplement, degree diploma)
- Qualification Statement: Evidence that admission requirements to the same Master's programme at a recognized university in the country where the Bachelor/ Diploma degree was obtained are fulfilled for the semester/ academic year in which admission is sought in Graz, including the general duration of this programme. (not necessary for EU/ EEA nationals)
- c. Students continuing their studies: Doctorate
- Evidence of accomplished Bachelor & Master, or Diploma (transcripts of records/diploma supplement, degree diplomas)
- Qualification Statement: Evidence that admission requirements to the same Doctorate programme at a recognized university in the country where the Master/Diploma degree was obtained are fulfilled for the semester/academic year in which admission is sought in Graz, including the general duration of this programme. (not necessary for EU/ EEA nationals)

3.) Language Requirements

Generally, the language of instruction is German. Only individual study programmes are offered in English. The following language certificates have to be handed in accordingly. The certificates must not be older than 2 years at the time of the application.

For study programmes in German (at least German A2 level according to GERS): ÖSD, Goethe Institut, DSD1, ÖIF, DTÖ, Integrationsprüfung, Vorstudienlehrgangs-Zeugnis. Attention: for starting the study programme, a C1 German language level is necessary!

English study programmes: TOEFL iBT (score of at least 95), IELTS Academic (score of at least 7), Cambridge Proficiency English CPE or Cambridge Advanced English CAE (score of at least 180/ Grade C or better)

4.) Entrance Examination

- 5.) Status equivalence of international students The following persons have equal admission status as Austrian citizens:
- persons who have had their main living interests in Austria for at least five continuous years immediately before applying for admission, or who have at least one person legally responsible for the applicant's alimony, for whom this applies;
- persons with secondary school leaving certificates of Austrian International Schools;
- · conventional refugees.

6.) Legalization of original documents

<u>All documents</u> must be submitted in their <u>original form</u> (<u>no copies</u>). The mode of legalization depends on the issuing state and certifies the authenticity of the original document.

- Original documents with full diplomatic authenticcation have to pass the mode of legalization of the issuing country (last station: Ministry for Foreign Affairs) and finally be legalized by the Austrian mission in the respective country (e.g. Austrian Embassy, Consulate). Such as: China, Egypt, Iran, Kosovo, Mongolia, Nigeria, Pakistan, etc.
- Original documents issued, for example, in one of the following countries do not need legalization: Belgium, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Finland, France, Germany, Hungary, Italy, Liechtenstein, Montenegro, the Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Romania, Sweden, Serbia, Slovakia and Slovenia.
- Original documents issued in a country having joined the Hague convention of October 5th 1961 (BGBI.Nr. 27/1968) only need legalization by means of "Apostille" by the respective domestic authorities. Such as: Albania, Argentina, Armenia, Australia, Cyprus, Great Britain and Northern Ireland, Ireland, India, Greece, Israel, Japan, Mexico, Russia, South Africa, Spain, Switzerland, Turkey, Ukraine, the United States, etc.

7.) Translations

Documents issued in foreign languages (except English) always have to be translated into German or English by a sworn and officially accredited translator. The translation should be linked with the original or with a notarized copy.

8.) Certificates of the Preparatory Courses

Students, who have already participated in exams of an Austrian Preparatory Programme (Vorstudienlehrgang) have to hand in the obtained certificates with the application.
