

REGISTRATION & COURSE FEE

COMPUTER-BASED ONLINE PLACEMENT

(Participants with German skills)

The computer-based placement includes reading comprehension and language structures, there is no oral placement. It is mandatory for participants taking **their first German course** at *treffpunkt sprachen*. Only for participants WITH prior knowledge of German!

REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT FOR STUDENTS

In order to participate in a language course, you have to:

1. Register via UNIGRAZonline **from Thursday, 18 February (1 pm) to Monday, 22 February 2021 (midnight)** and receive a confirmed place (**first come, first served!**).
2. Transfer the course fee in time. Deadline for paying is Monday, 22 February 2021. You also have to send a confirmation of payment to kursbeitrag.daf@uni-graz.at. You can find the details in the course description in UNIGRAZonline (additional information).

Course fee (incl. a service charge of € 5)

- ▶ € 75 for students at the University of Graz and the TU Graz
- ▶ € 175 for non-degree programme students and students from other universities (Med Uni Graz and KUG)

Co-registration

Students from the University of Technology (TU Graz), the Medical University of Graz (Med Uni Graz) and the University of Music and Performing Arts of Graz (KUG) who want to participate in a German intensive or semester course at *treffpunkt sprachen*, have to be co-registered at the University of Graz in order to receive a grade and ECTS credits.

REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT FOR EMPLOYEES AND EXTERNAL PARTICIPANTS

They comply with academic as well as European standards (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages of the Council of Europe). The German semester courses in summer term 2021 will be taught online.

The number of participants is limited. *treffpunkt sprachen* reserves the right to cancel courses. Course fees are refunded only in case of cancelled courses.

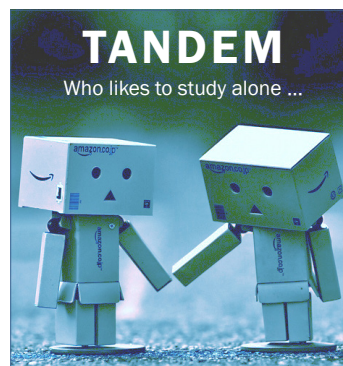
RECORD OF ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT

Course certificate for students: 80% attendance, regular participation, achievement of course goals, homework assignments, written or oral exam at the end of the semester. The certificate can be printed via UNIGRAZonline after the end of the course (see "Exam Results").

Confirmation of participation for employees and external participants: at least 70% attendance, active participation, achievement of course goals, homework assignments.

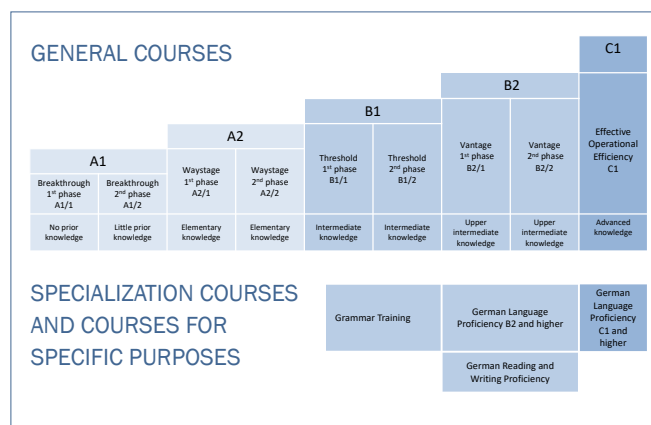

OVERVIEW COURSES

Each German course takes place **once a week** for two semester hours (90 minutes, corresponds to 3 ECTS). *treffpunkt sprachen* offers two course types:

- ▶ **General courses:** level A1/1st phase to C1; one phase per semester; learning progression in grammar and vocabulary in communication situations.
- ▶ **Specialization courses and courses for specific purposes:** level B1 and higher; two or more courses can be combined with each other and/or with general courses, depending on the course level.
