The Centre for Lifelong Learning is a long established and internationally recognised centre of excellence offering a wide range of taught and distance/online programmes for adult students. There are approximately 8,000 students studying a wide range of subjects relevant to the personal, social and vocational needs of adults. The Centre has for this past 25 years offered programmes specifically geared toward the needs of older adults. More than 2,000 students are enrolled on

the learning in later life programme. The students have established their own student association which has more than 900 members and which organises a wide range of nonformal learning activities through student clubs. Recently the Association established a student research group which is carrying out its own research and providing support to researchers of older adults.
