Helmut Vogt Academic Director, Centre for Continuing Education (AWW), University of Hamburg Deputy Chair, German Association for University Continuing and Distance Education (DGWF)



Helmut Vogt has worked as Head of the Centre for Continuing Education (AWW) of the University of Hamburg since 1983. In 1994 he was elected as a member of the steering committee of the German Association for University Continuing and Distance Education (DGWF). In 1998 he became its Deputy Chairman which he is today.

Before he moved to Hamburg, he studied at the Free University of Berlin and worked as Head of Department in the Volkshochschule (adult education centre) of the northwestern German city of Emden. Mr Vogt holds a master's degree (Diplom) in adult education with a minor in political sciences, psychology and social sciences.

Helmut Vogt is a well-known expert in university continuing education (UCE) and distance education in Germany. As such he assesses institutions of higher education, works as a reviewer in accrediting study programmes, advises governments of the German Federal States (Länder) and counsels other UCE centres and colleagues.

He has organised conferences both at regional and national level, contributes presentations and posters to conferences in Germany and other European countries, and offers his expertise in a number of advisory boards and commissions.

His main fields of expertise are: university continuing education, distance education, university lifelong learning.

Helmut Vogt has published a number of articles, particularly in the fields of organising and financing UCE, web-based portals for UCE and university lifelong learning.
