

Associate Professor Dr. Martin Polaschek Vice Rector for Studies and Teaching at the University of Graz



After taking his degree in Law at the University of Graz, Martin Polaschek qualified himself as a university lecturer in 2000 and was appointed associate university professor at the Institute for Austrian Legal History and European Legal Development. Dr. Polaschek has not only been Vice Rector for Studies and Teaching since 2003, as Director of Studies, he has also been responsible for the concerns of more than 30,000 students since 2004. In addition, Martin Polaschek has always been an active researcher. His scientific focus is on Contemporary Legal History, federalism and community research. Moreover, he has been a member of the expert group on the future of teacher training.
