Dr. Ulrich Wacker University of Konstanz



Ulrich Wacker holds a Ph.D. in Economics from University of Konstanz, Germany. In 2003, when the University of Konstanz started to develop Lifelong Learning programs for professionals, he became the manager of the newly founded Academy of Advanced Studies. Dr. Wacker was primarily responsible for the

development of new programs and study formats and managed, for example, the development of the Sport Science Academy. As the University's consultant for Lifelong Learning, he is involved in the strategic integration of programs of advanced studies into the University's structures.

Since 2004 Dr. Wacker has also been the manager of the Thurgau Institute of Economics at the University of Konstanz (TWI). In 2007, the Institute became a cross-border center for experimental research in economics. Ulrich Wacker integrated the institute's experimental approaches and teaching formats into the programs of the Academy of Advanced Studies, e.g. into programs for teachers or the Academy's Summer and Autumn Schools.

Ulrich Wacker is Spokesperson of the Baden-Württemberg State Group in the German Association for University Continuing and Distance Education.
