## Carme Royo Executive Secretary of EUCEN



Carme Royo has been the Executive Secretary of EUCEN since July 2008. In this position, she is on the one hand supporting the EUCEN Steering Committee in the strategic positioning of the Association at European level and coordinating relationships to external stakeholders. On the other hand, she is responsible for

managing the day-to-day business of the Association, including the preparation of the annual work plan and budget, the monitoring of performance and the reporting. Due to the specific character of EUCEN, her responsibilities include building up effective collaboration with academic experts for the development of expertise in ULLL and relevant products such as publications, including the development and the project management of European projects.

Between 2000 and 2008 Carme Royo was Head of EUCEN's Executive Office. She has been working in university environments since 1994, when she was employed first at Sheffield Hallam University (UK). Soon afterwards she was recruited by the University of Sheffield (UK) to work with the Distance Learning Programme at the department of Automatic Control and Systems Engineering where she stayed until summer 1999, before returning to her home city, Barcelona.
