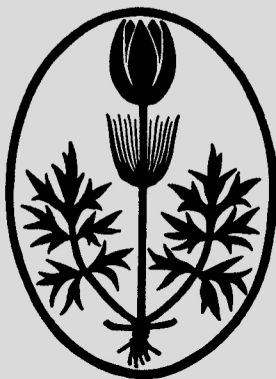

Biographical Data of Josef HAYNE, Professor of Botany at the Joanneum in Graz, Austria

Summary

TEPPNER H. 2015. Biographical data of Josef HAYNE, professor of botany at the Joanneum in Graz, Austria. – *Phyton* (Horn, Austria) 55 (1): 191–192, with 1 figure.

Josef HAYNE was born on March 19, 1788 in Krainburg (Kranj), nowadays Slovenia, studied medicine in Vienna and was designated as professor of botany at the Joanneum in Graz, Styria, Austria, on March 9, 1832. He died on April 30, 1835.

Zusammenfassung

Josef HAYNE wurde am 19. März 1788 in Krainburg (Kranj), heute Slowenien, geboren. Er studierte in Wien Medizin und wurde am 9. März 1832 zum Professor der Botanik am Joanneum in Graz ernannt. Todestag ist der 30. April 1835.

From the Nadškofjski arhiv in Ljubljana we received a transcription from the parish register of the parish Krainburg / Kranj in Slovenia (NSAL, ŽA Kranj, Taufbuch 1771–1798). Accordingly, Josef HAYNE (later spellings also Joseph HEYNE and others) was born on March 19, 1788 in Krainburg 172; parents: Anton HAYNE (chirurgus) and Teresia SKOPIN. J. HAYNE studied science of medicine in Vienna and was a professor of natural history from 1830–1832 at the “Erzherzoglichen Ökonomischen Institut in Ungarisch-Altenburg (Mosonmagyaróvár, Hungary)” (SVOJTKA 2010: 54).

On June 24, 1830 the provincial deputies of Styria addressed a motion to Emperor Franz I. for the permission to divide the chair for botany and chemistry of the predecessor v. VEST at the Joanneum in Graz and to give the botany to Josef HAYNE. The permission is dated with March 9, 1832 (TEPPNER 2015).

The date of HAYNE's early death is April 30, 1835 (see death list, Fig. 1). MARKTANNER–TURNERETSCHER 1911: 252 indicated a wrong date. The spelling of the first name in the list of death (Joseph) is different from the parish register (Josef) and the age (44) is apparently wrong (correct 47).

Josef HAYNE should not be confused with Friedrich Gottlob HAYNE (1763, Jüterbog – 1832, Berlin).
