Privacy Statement

Database of women habilitated in Austria

The University of Graz takes its data protection very seriously and is committed to protecting and processing your personal data in accordance with the legal regulations.

According to Art 12 and 13 DS-GVO, this privacy statement shall inform you about the purpose, legal basis and about your rights in connection with the processing of your personal data by the University of Graz, Universitätsplatz 3, 8010 Graz.

Purpose and legal basis for data processing and the respective storage period:

By completing and submitting the data sheet for inclusion in the database of women habilitated in Austria, you consent to the processing of the personal data provided by you in this data sheet for the purpose of selecting and sending suitable, current professorship vacancies, as well as for sending inquiries regarding expert opinions and commission memberships.

We will process the following personal data: Title/academic degree, first and last name, date of birth, university/workplace, institute/center, address, country, e-mail address, telephone number, homepage, habilitation field, habilitation university, habilitation date, title of habilitation thesis, key area of expertise.

Your personal data will be stored until you tell us otherwise. In the case of revocation, only your absolutely necessary personal data will be stored for the purpose of proving your consent or revocation for a period of 3 years from revocation.

After reaching the age of 65, your entry will be deleted from our database. If you wish to keep your record in the database for a longer period of time, we kindly ask you to inform us in writing.

Target group:

Women habilitated in Austria up to the age of 65 or, if requested, longer.

Transmission of your data:

Your personal data will only be processed within the university and we will not distribute your personal information to third parties.

Your rights:

In relation to us processing your personal data you have the following rights, which can be exercised at any time at the University of Graz as the responsible party, mail address: akgl@uni-graz.at:

- Right to information about your personal data (Art 15 DSGVO),
- Right to rectification (Art 16 DS-GVO) or deletion (Art 17 DS-GVO) or to restriction of the processing of your data (Art 18 DS-GVO),
- Right to data portability (Art 20 DS-GVO),
- Right to object (Art 21 DS-GVO),
- Right to withdraw consent (Art 7(3) DS-GVO), which does not affect the lawfulness of the processing carried out on the basis of the consent prior to revocation.

In addition, there is the
