Application form	signed by applicant on page 2
Curriculum vitae (CV)	must be up to date
*Enrollment confirmation	issued by the admissions office of the home university for the current academic year including name and level of the degree programme
*Transcript of records	Transcript of the degree programme the applicant is currently enrolled in

Research proposal	Detailed research proposal indicating the intended research to be undertaken at University of Graz including information on general objectives / goals, research approach / methodology, research questions, expected results of research stay
Invitation letter	signed by a professor in the relevant academic field at University of Graz (use template available for download in Mobility-Online)
2 Recommendation letters in English or German or incl. English or German translation	issued by professors at the applicant's home university, one of which must be issued by the official thesis supervisor. Recommendation letters must be issued on official letter head of the home university and include name, contact details and signature of the professor.
Passport, identity page	EU citizens: national ID card also accepted In case of dual nationality > upload both passports in one PDF-file.
Language confirmation	confirming level B2 in the working language relevant for the research stay: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • official language certificate or • confirmation by the home university (use template available for download in Mobility-Online)
Proof of accreditation	Only if specifically requested by the Office of International Relations
