

COURSE SEARCH without login

You have two options when searching for courses without login BEFORE you are fully enrolled:

- If you do not speak German and want to focus on English-taught courses online, check for courses via our **Search-Tool for English-taught courses**.
- If your German level is B2 or higher and you intend to take courses in German or combine courses in German and English, you should check for courses in the **online course guide**.

General instructions for course search

- Students starting their **mobility in the fall** will have to work with the **courses of the previous academic year** as the courses for any given year only go online in July prior to the winter semester.
- When searching for courses make sure you **select the semester/term** you will be spending at University of Graz (20xx**S** = summer semester, 20xx**W** = winter semester). Just as a reminder: winter semester = September to end of January, summer semester = February to end of June
- **Searching by degree program:** select the curriculum (= degree program) relevant for your degree program at your home university. Make sure you select programs **at the level you are also currently enrolled in at your home university** (bachelor students = bachelor level program, master level = master level program, doctoral level = doctoral level program).
- **Searching by keyword:** enter the relevant keyword without first selecting a degree program and the system will list all courses with this keyword. Note that in this case you will have to check the level of each course (bachelor, master, doctoral program) in the course description to see if it is the correct level for you.
- **Changes to the intended courses** within the same field and level of study are still possible ahead of course registration deadlines prior to the semester start.
- **Make a list of your intended courses incl. course number and course title for further use**
 - course upload in your application
 - course registration prior to the semester
 - Communication with professors regarding the course
- The **decision on credit transfer** lies exclusively with the home university. In case of any question, check with your home coordinator.

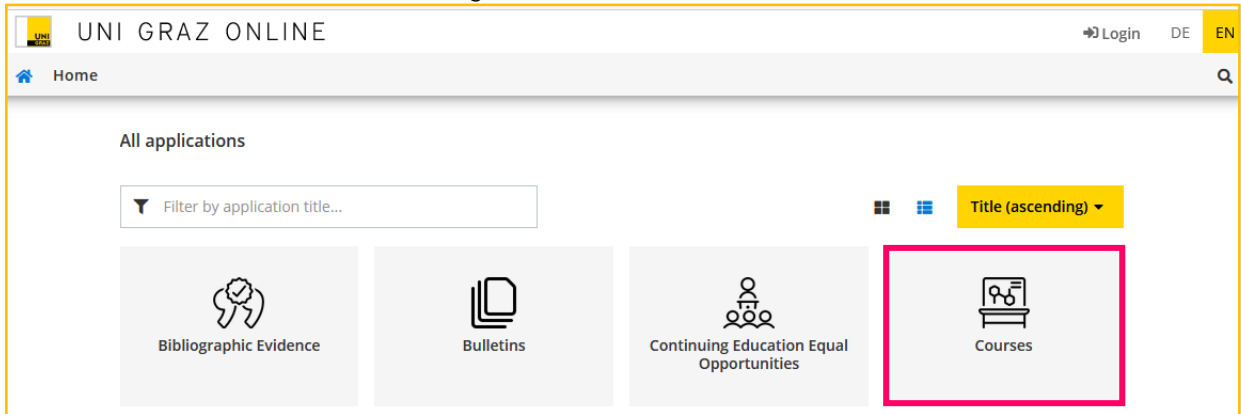

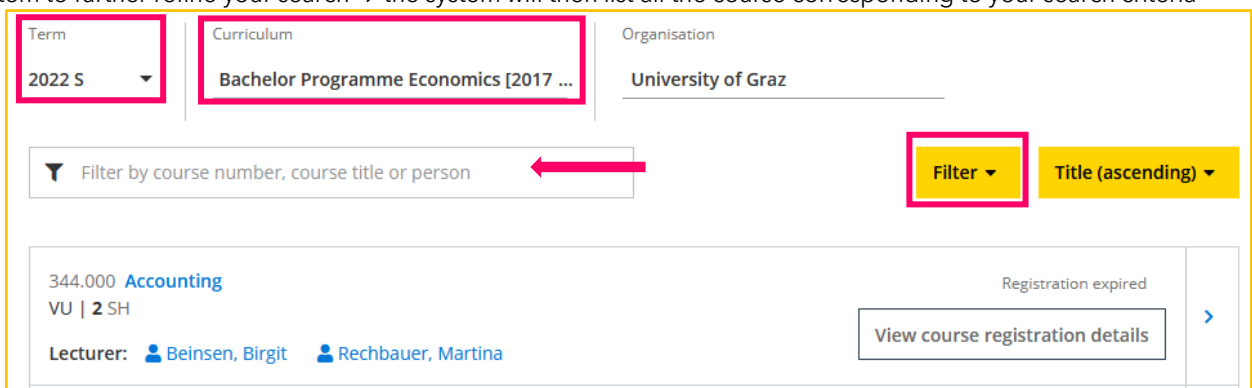
