Conference Information

On 10th to 12th of October, the Commission for German History and Culture in Southeastern Europe will hold her annual conference to „**Deportation Practices and Experiences in the Early Modern Period. The Habsburg Monarchy in International Comparison**“ in Tübingen (Germany). The SOG18 will act as one of the cooperation partners ([program as attachment](#)).

On 24th to 26th of October, at university of Sofia will be held the international conference „**250 Years of Geopolitics and Geostrategy in the Eastern Question. The Peace Treaty of Kjachuk-Kainarji (1774) and the balance of power in Europe during the long Eighteenth century**“. The SOG18 will act as cooperation partner ([program as attachment](#)).

From 1st to 4th of May, 2025, at university of Graz will be held the conference „**Baroque and Orthodoxy in the Carpathian, Danubian and Adriatic Sea space**“. The SOG18 will act as one of the cooperation partners.

Publications

Yearbook Nr. 8 will contain the results of the conference to “**The beginning of secularisation in Europe’s Southeast**” which was held on 30th of May to 1st of June 2024. The number will go online at the beginning of May, 2025. In addition, it is planned to publish this yearbook in a limited printed edition.
