



Data Protection Declaration

EAERE Summer School in Resource and Environmental Economics

As controller, the University of Graz takes data protection very seriously and will treat your personal data confidentially and in accordance with the legal requirements.

In accordance with Articles 12 and 13 of the GDPR, this Data Protection Declaration aims to inform you, as a participant in the abovementioned event held by the University of Graz, of the purpose of processing your personal data, the legal basis for this and your rights in this regard.

Scope, purpose(s) and legal basis/bases

In connection with managing applications and registrations for the event and organising and holding the event itself, we will process the following personal data for the purpose of fulfilling the contract or in order to take steps prior to entering into a contract in accordance with Article 6 (1) (b) of the GDPR: Name, date of birth, gender, nationality, contact details (e-mail address, postal address, phone), application details (affiliation, title of the submitted paper, name of supervisor, start and (planned) completion of PhD studies).

If you would like to receive a scholarship, we will process the following personal data for this purpose in accordance with Article 6 (1) (b) of the GDPR: Name, date of birth, gender, nationality, contact details (e-mail address, postal address, phone) and account details.

We need to process this data in order to fulfil the contract. If you do not disclose this data to us, you cannot take part in the event and/or receive a scholarship.

Photographs will be taken at the event for the purpose of reporting on and documenting it. We will publish a selection of these photos, (without naming anyone featured in them), in media such as the EAERE Summer School Uni Graz website and the newsletter of the department of Economics at the University of Graz. As you might be identifiably depicted in the photos, those are personal data.

It is processed (and published) in the legitimate or public interests of the University of Graz with regard to public relations, presenting its activities and informing the public about scientific activities in accordance with Article 6 (1) (f) resp (e) GDPR in conjunction with § 3 (11) Universities Act (UG).

Storage period

In the case of a contract: We will store your personal data for as long as it is needed in connection with organising and holding the event. Aside from this, we only store your data if there are statutory retention periods for this (e.g. Section 132 of the Austrian Federal Taxation Code (BAO)) or if the limitation periods related to potential legal claims are open.



In the case of legitimate resp. public interests: We will process the data for as long as required to safeguard the legitimate resp. public interests or until a (justified) objection is raised. Aside from this, we only store your data if there are statutory retention periods for this or if the limitation periods related to potential legal claims are open.

Transmission of your personal data

Your data will be processed within the University and will also be forwarded to the European Association of Environmental and Resource Economists (EAERE). On the one hand, this is for information purposes, as we organize the Summer School on behalf of the EAERE and on the other hand this is to check whether you have concluded an EAERE membership for the year of the event, as this is a prerequisite for participation in the event.

Your rights

Your rights according to GDPR to be exercised under [eaere-summer-school @unigraz.at](mailto:eaere-summer-school@unigraz.at) are:

- The right to access your data (Article 15 of the GDPR),
- The right to rectification (Article 16 of the GDPR),
- The right to erasure (Article 17 of the GDPR),
- The right to restriction of processing (Article 18 of the GDPR),
- The right to data portability (Article 20 of the GDPR),
- The right to object (Article 21, of the GDPR),

You also have the right to lodge a complaint (Article 77 of the GDPR). Complaints should be lodged with the relevant supervisory authority, which in Austria is the Austrian Data Protection Authority, Barichgasse 40-42, 1030 Vienna, e-mail: dsb@dsb.gv.at.
