

GETTING THERE from the conference site (Merangasse 70):

Bus 63 (direction Hauptbahnhof) / get off at "Lendplatz" 5 minutes footpath into direction of the city centre (passing the fire brigade)

Tram 1 (Eggenberg / UKH), **4** (Reininghaus), **6** (Smart City) or **7** (Laudongasse) / get off at the "Südtirolerplatz/Kunsthaus" / from there 7 minutes' walk to Lendplatz, along Mariahilferstrasse.





DAY 2: Friday, 23.05.2025, 18:00 – 19:30

City tour with Joachim Hainzl Diversity of languages, (socio)cultures, and religions

Migrants have shaped and influenced the history of the city of Graz, in past and present. Our tour explores historical and current issues related to migrants, leading from the bourgeois city center to the other side of the river Mur. The former suburban districts of Lend and Gries are currently areas where diversity is still highly visible today.

Graz-based social pedagogue Joachim Hainzl has been working for decades on topics related to everyday life and the social history of the city, as well as on aspects of work and educational migration.

Starting point: Hauptplatz, in front of the town hall

If you want to go together by tram:

We meet at 17:30 in the inner courtyard of the WALL building (ground floor)

Information on public transportation in Graz:

In Graz, you can go either on bus or on tram.

A one-hour ticket costs €3.10, while a 24-hour ticket costs €6.70.

You can buy tickets in ticket machines in buses, trams and stationary ticket machines or in shops called 'Trafik'.

On buses, only cashless payment is accepted.

On trams, at stations and shops, cash payment is also possible.
