

OPAC-IROWG 2026: Graz Airport to Seggau Castle

Short version: Buy your **train ticket** online ("Flughafen Graz" to "Leibnitz Bahnhof", € 9.10 or € 18.20), follow the black train symbols on yellow background / the **covered walkway** (350 meters), find **platform 2 = direction Spielfeld** by following the **path around the construction site**. Take the **S1** (every 30 minutes) to **Leibnitz**, call a **taxi**: +43345275570 (Taxi Silvia – if you mention the Wegener Center or OPAC, they know where you have to go; they accept payment via card.)

Note: Credit cards aren't accepted everywhere in Austria, especially for small expenses. **We therefore recommend you get some cash/Euros. The last ATM is at the airport.** ATMs in Leibnitz are approx. 40 minutes on foot from the castle.

Note: Due to construction at the railway station, **we recommend you buy your ticket online when you arrive at the airport (WIFI available): <https://shop.oebbtickets.at/en/ticket>** The ticket machine at the railway station is on the other side of the tracks and it will probably take up to ten minutes longer until you are on the right platform. You have two choices of ticket: € 9.10 for the exact train you'll be taking; or € 18.20 for a ticket that is valid on any train to Leibnitz for 24 hours.

You have made it to Graz Airport, congrats! It is tiny, so after baggage claim etc. you'll immediately land in the foyer. Keep a look out for a **black train symbols on yellow background**. Take the exit a few meters to the left.



Follow the **covered walkway**, keeping the airport tower to your right. Cross the two-lane road by the roundabout, keep following the covered walkway.



- Already have a train ticket? Turn left before the construction site.



Resume directions at the green tag in this document.

- No train ticket yet? Follow directions to platform 1 & "Ticketautomat": Take the **underpass** to the other side of the railtracks, **turn right** and cross the road, **turn back towards the tracks**, take the **bridge** towards the construction site. The ticket machine is located in a little cabin (between garbage cans and a mobile toilet). Buy your ticket: "Flughafen Graz" to "Leibnitz Bahnhof", € 9.10.



Walk all the way back through under the tracks, follow the signage towards **platform 2** = direction of Spielfeld.

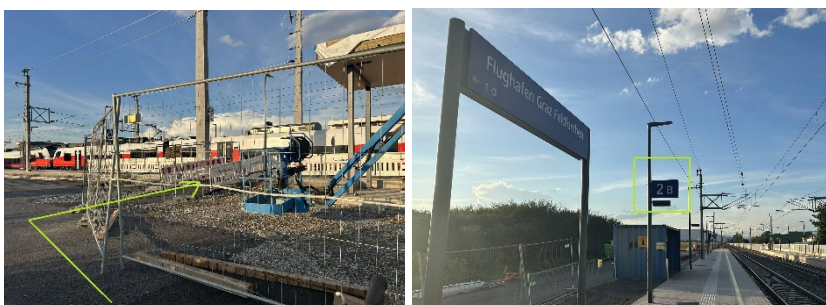
Back on track towards platform 2: Do not be deterred by the construction site! **Follow the signage to platform 2 = direction of Spielfeld.**



Yes, we are not kidding – **follow the little path** between bushes and fence, **turn right** towards the traintracks (rainbow now guaranteed).



And you've reached platform 2! The screen with scheduled departures is located in the blue construction hut.



While you wait, order a taxi:

- Taxi Silvia +43345275570
- Tell them your estimated time of arrival at Leibnitz.
- The ride will probably cost around € 13.
- If you mention the Wegener Center or OPAC, they know where to pick you up in Leibnitz and to drop you off at the castle (or at your hotel, if you stay somewhere else).

Take the S1 towards Spielfeld (or Leibnitz), exit at Leibnitz. Between 6:45 and 23:45, there's a train every 30 minutes at xx:15 and xx:45 (full timetable:

https://www.verbundlinie.at/components/com_timetable/uploads/81-S1-m-j26-1.pdf).

The ride to Leibnitz takes **25 minutes** (5 stops between Flughafen and Leibnitz).

Take a taxi to Seggau Castle ("Hotel Schloss Seggau"). Either you call for one at +43345275570 (Taxi Silvia, see above) or you catch one at Leibnitz Railway Station (availability not guaranteed).

(Note: Taxi Silvia takes rides from the airport to Castle Seggau. Those cost approx. € 90.)

By default, the **hotel registration is open until 21:00**. If you arrive later, please inform the hotel (and also us).

As sad as it is, at some point, you will probably have to leave. **To get back to Graz Airport**, take a taxi to Bahnhof Leibnitz and the S1 from there to the airport (direction Mürzzuschlag or Bruck, leaving every 30 minutes at xx:19 and xx:49, exit "Flughafen Graz"). Follow the signage to the airport – crossing the train tracks via underpass, following the covered walkway. The departure zone is on the right side of the airport building.
