Other topics may be equally well-suited for the fellowship, provided there is a clear and well-argued advantage to working on them at the Faculty of Law of University of Graz.

Your Profile (Junior Fellowship):

- You hold an LL.B. (first-class honours), LL.M., or an equivalent degree in Law
- You are currently working on a PhD thesis in Law or have at least two years of work experience after graduation
- You have either excellent English or excellent German Language Skills

Your Profile (Senior Fellowship):

- You have an outstanding academic record and are internationally well-renowned in your field
- You currently hold a position as a Full Professor, Assistant Professor, Lecturer, Reader, or Post-Doc Researcher
- You have either excellent English or excellent German Language Skills

During your stay:

- You have multiple opportunities to discuss your research project with leading experts in their field at University of Graz
- You are given the opportunity to work on a specific publication project and present your results at the end of your stay

Your benefits are:

- An environment of excellent researchers with know-how in your area
- The chance to carry out interdisciplinary work across faculties at the University of Graz for 2-3 months
- A monthly scholarship of 1,800 € for Senior Fellows and 1,500 € for Junior Fellows
