- Transcript of Records/certificates/module description (original or certified copy) + certified translation
- Bachelor's / master's / doctoral / diploma thesis (including 10-page abstract in German or English)
- Proof that nostrification is mandatory for the continuation of the professional or educational path in Austria (e.g. confirmation notice of the State School Board, etc.)
- o Proof of payment of the nostrification tax amounting to EUR 150.-

It is required to submit either the original documents or a certified copy of those documents with the exception of the award certificate, which must always be the original. Foreign-language documents must be submitted together with a certified copy. Foreign documents must be duly certified.
