

Theses entailing Empirical Studies: New Grant Program at the Faculty of Humanities

Objective: To support students at the Faculty of Humanities who conduct an empirical study as part of their final thesis (dissertation or master's thesis); both qualitative and quantitative studies are eligible.

Pilot phase in the academic year 2023/24

Submissions are open on an ongoing basis from October 2023 until mid-June 2024

Requirements for application:

- Applicant must be a registered student in the Faculty of Humanities
- Topic of dissertation/master's thesis must have been reported and approved

What should be submitted?

- Description of the planned study incl. specification of costs and time schedule
- Confirmation of the supervisor that the empirical study is central to the writing of the thesis

The application including all accompanying material (max. 5 A4 pages in total) must be submitted in an informal e-mail to gewi.dekanat@uni-graz.at.

The Vice-Dean, the Dean of Studies and the Vice-Dean of the Faculty of Humanities will decide on the awarding of the grant.

If the application is approved, a maximum of 200 euros will be granted for a master's thesis and a maximum of 400 euros for a dissertation.

The final report on the study as well as a statement of costs (max. 3 A4 pages in total) must be submitted 6 months after approval in case of a master's thesis and 12 months after approval in case of a dissertation.
