ADOLF LIEBEN LECTURER 2024:

Our lecturer 2024 is **Prof.ⁱⁿ Sabine Flitsch**, University of Manchester.

Born in Münster, Germany, Prof.ⁱⁿ Flitsch studied chemistry at the University of Münster. She then moved to the University of Oxford where she obtained her PhD with Sir Jack Baldwin. Following a Post-Doctoral stay at MIT with Prof. Har G. Khorana, she returned to Oxford as a lecturer in 1988. In 1995 she joined the university of Edinburgh and in 2004 she became the Chair in Chemical Biology at the University of Manchester.



Prof.ⁱⁿ Flitsch is well-known for her pioneering work in the integration of biocatalysis and synthetic chemistry, particularly her groundbreaking contributions to enzyme engineering, glycoscience, and the development of new biotransformations.
