Aljoscha Neubauer, studied psychology and sociology at University of Graz, Austria (Ph.D. 1986), habilitation 1994. 1995/96 visiting professor at the Goethe-University in Frankfurt. 1997 William Stern Award for outstanding contributions to Differential Psychology; 2022 Lifetime Achievement Award of the International Society of Intelligence Research (ISIR); 2024 Franz Emanuel Weinert-Preis, awarded by the Deutsche Gesellschaft für Psychologie (DGPs). Since 1998 professor of Differential Psychology at department of psychology of the University of Graz; he was head of department and vice-dean. He was president of different scientific societies (ISIR, ISSID, Austrian Psychology Soc.). Main research focus is on human abilities (intelligence, creativity, social/emotional competences) and their neurophysiological bases. Editor/associate editor or editorial board member of several international journals (e.g. Intelligence, Personality and Individual Differences). More than 300 publications (>150 publications in peer reviewed journals, >100 science-to-public contributions, articles, interviews etc., >30 book chapters, several books and psychological tests.
