Conference Information

The Conference „**1821 and Memoir. Historical Use and Historiographic Knowledge**“ was held in Athens on 21st-22nd of March. At this conference the executive board member *Olga Katsiardi-Hering* spoke about „The Austrian Naval Policy in the Levant during the Greek Revolution“.

The conference “**Habsburg rule and representation/ Herrschaft und Repräsentation in der Habsburgermonarchie (1700-1740)**” was held on 28th-29th of March in Vienna. At the conference two SOG18 members were involved: *Stefan Seitschek* (Organizer, Speaker) and *Sabine Jesner* (Speaker).
