## **Recent Publications**

The first online volume of the source edition "Voices of an era of transition. South Eastern Europe in the long 18<sup>th</sup> century" will be published in the middle of 2018. A second volume is planned for 2019 (see Newsletter 4/2018).

The Board sent out in last autumn a first call for articles to an online lexicon to "Sites of Innovation for South Eastern Europe in the 18<sup>th</sup> century". The articles in German (!) for this lexicon will be published online currently after being reviewed and redacted. Exemplary articles as orientation will be published as soon as possible at the website.

## **Actual Program**

The exhibition "We and Požarevac. 300 years impact on Europe" is going to be opened at 5<sup>th</sup> of April, 2018 in the Arsenal ("Landeszeughaus") in Graz. It will be presented till the end of October, 2018. A short overview will be published at the website after opening.

At 20<sup>th</sup>-22<sup>th</sup> of September under the title "*Prosperity and Representation. Economic Recovery in the Danube Basin (1718-1918)*" will be held a conference in Graz. This conference is a cooperation project of the Commission of German Studies in South Eastern Europe (Tübingen/Germany) with SOG18 (Further details see Newsletter 3/2018).

On 10<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> of May, 2019 will be realised the next conference in Graz. This conference will be combined with the first General Assembly of the SOG18 members. The call for the program will be published in Newsletter 3/2018.
