Recent Publication

The Board of SOG18 is going to publish the first online volume of the source-edition "Voices of an era of transition. South Eastern Europe in the long 18th century" in the middle of 2018. Articles to the first volume are asked latest till 31th of March. A second volume is planned for 2019.

The Board has also sent out the call for articles to an online lexicon to "Sites of Innovation for South Eastern Europe in the 18th century". The articles in German (!) for this lexicon will be published online currently after being reviewed and redacted. Exemplary articles as orientation will be published at the website in February, 2018.

Actual Program

At 16th of November the first saloon was proceeded at university of Graz. The two speakers Thomas Wallnig (President of the Austrian Society for 18th Century Studies) and Grete Walter-Klingenstein (Austrian Academy of Science) discussed about "*The role of the 18th century for the Habsburg Monarchy*" (See separate file). Other saloons will be intended.

The exhibition "We and Požarevac. 300 years impact on Europe" will be opened at 5th of April, 2018 in the Arsenal ("Zeughaus") in Graz and will be presented till the end of October, 2018 (Further details see Neswletter 2/2018).

At 20th-22th of September under the title "*Prosperity and Representation. Economic Recovery in the Danube Basin (1718-1918)*" will be held a conference in Graz. This project is a cooperation of SOG18 with the Commission of German Studies in South Eastern Europe (Tübingen/Germany) (Further details see Newsletter 3/2018).

In May 2019 will be realised the next conference in Graz. This conference will be combined with the first General Assembly of the SOG18 members (Further details see Newsletter 2/2018).
