PostDoc Peer Mentoring Team 2024: Call for Participants & Application Form

Peer mentoring means that postdoctoral researchers work together as a closed group for a year to enhance their professional development. The PostDoc Peer Mentoring Team is intended for persons interested in receiving and giving support to/from peers outside their immediate work area

- on career steps (within or beyond academia)
- on work- & life-balance related topics

The programme, now in its third year, works on the assumption that each of the group members has an advantage of knowledge, skills and experience in a specific domain that they can make accessible to the others. Additional knowledge and training will be provided by subject-matter experts and professional career coaches.

The group will consist of up to 15 participants. It is interdisciplinary, mixed-gender, and will last from spring 2024 until spring 2025. The working language is determined within the group. The Team is supported by the PostDoc Office in organizational matters.

- you are a postdoctoral researcher employed on a temporary contract at the University of Graz at the time of application
- you can commit to stay with the Peer Mentoring Team for one year and can fit the dates listed below into your schedule
