### PostDoc Peer Mentoring Team 2025: Call for Participants & Time Schedule

Peer mentoring means that a closed group of postdoctoral researchers works together for a year to enhance their professional development. This "PostDoc Peer Mentoring Team" is intended for persons interested in receiving and giving support to/from colleagues outside their immediate work area

- on career steps (within or beyond academia)
- on work- & life-balance related topics

The programme, now in its fourth year, works on the assumption that each of the group members has an advantage of knowledge, skills and experience in a specific domain that they can make accessible to the others. Additional knowledge and training will be provided by subject-matter experts and professional career coaches.

The group will consist of up to 15 participants. It is interdisciplinary, mixed-gender, and will last from spring 2025 until spring 2026. The working language is determined within the group.
