„Caring democracy: the role that theoretically-astute understandings of ethnicity and race must play“

(Prof. Sandra Torres, University of Uppsala, Sweden)

This keynote presentation argues that the ways in which ethnicity and race are made sense of in scholarship on aging and old age needs to be problematized. The presentation builds on a scoping review of the last twenty years of scholarship on the intersection of aging/ old age and ethnicity/ race (n=336) as well as a recent secondary analysis of this data corpus focusing specifically on racialization and racism and uses the notion of caring democracy to argue that in order to advance our understandings of these identification grounds we need to abandon the essentialist ways in which we tend to make sense of them. The presentation aims to expand the imagination of scholars who work on the intersection in question by suggesting that our analytical gaze needs to be turned onto our scholarship as well the policies and practices that are designed to cater to older ethnic and racial minorities since it is through research, policy and practice that these identification grounds are made meaningful.
