About UNMO

Dzemat Bijedic University of Mostar was founded on February 11, 1977. Today it consists of eight faculties, which all have adopted Bologna principles. Since July 2015 University is accredited higher educational institution and it is one of eight public higher education institutions in Bosnia and Herzegovina.



Student Union

Students are organized in the University's Student Union. Organization is entirely student-run, and manage their own annual budgets.

The activities of the Union of Students are:

Academic calendar

An academic year has two semesters (winter and summer) within which three examination periods are planned.

Winter semester

Lecture period begins in the first week of October and lasts up to mid-January (around 15 January), which is 15 weeks.

Exam period is organized in 2 examination terms from fourth week of January until end of third week of February

Summer semester

Classes in the summer semester begin at the end of February and end in mid-June of the same year.

The summer semester is followed by the two examination periods from the third week of June until third week of July.
