## Conference Information

The annual seminar of the International Society for Eighteenth Century Studies (ISECS) was organized in this year by SOG18. This seminar with the title “**Wartimes in 18<sup>th</sup> Century. Perceptions and Memories**” was held on 19<sup>th</sup> - 21<sup>th</sup> of September in Graz. 15 young scholars from Germany, Italy, France, Great Britain, Poland, Spain, US, Canada and Austria presented their doctoral projects. The president of the International Society for Eighteenth Century Studies, Penelope Corfield, joint and moderated one panel.



The next congress of the International Society for Eighteenth Century Studies with the title “**Antiquity and the Shaping of the Future in the Age of Enlightenment**” will be held in Rome on 3<sup>th</sup>-7<sup>th</sup> of July, 2023 (see <https://isecs-roma2023.net>).
