CEEPUS summer course Romance studies in Central Europe

Scholarship information

After being informally nominated by their local CEEPUS network coordinator, the students must register on the CEEPUS website <www.ceepus.info> according to the "Instruction CEEPUS web application" (see <romanistik.uni-graz.at>). Students from Kraków and Zagreb must register as "freemovers", students from the other four universities as regular students within the FISH network.

The scholarship for the course comprises:

- accommodation from July 12th to July 19th in single rooms in a student dormitory;
- vouchers for five meals in the university restaurant;
- the lunch on Saturday, July 18th;
- 110 euros in cash for travel expenses, which will be paid at the end of the course (but must be retained in case of serious damages to the dormitory room).

Breakfasts are not included, but the dormitory buildings are equipped with kitchens where to prepare the breakfast. The students should not forget to bring their own towels and bed linens.

Before their arrival to Graz, the students will receive an e-mail from the student dormitory administration (*Wirtschaftshilfe für Studierende*, WIST) with information on the internet access in their rooms.

The scholarship holders should come to the Institut für Romanistik, Merangasse 70, 3rd floor, room 33.3.074, on Sunday, July 12th, between 3 and 8 pm, to register and pick up the keys for their dormitory rooms. Students arriving before or after these hours should contact us as soon as possible.

On the day of departure, July 19th, at 8 o'clock am, the students should go to the office of the student dormitory administration (*Wirtschaftshilfe für Studierende*, WIST) in Moserhofgasse 34, deliver the key and receive the 110 euros.

The housing is not organised by the *Österreichischer akademischer Austauschdienst* (OeAD). Therefore, you are not required to leave a 250 Euro security deposit. Neither are you required to go to the local OeAD office during the week of your stay. Registration and housing are organised by the Institut für Romanistik.

If attended regularly, the summer course is valid 3 ECTS.
