We invite submissions for the section **Clinical Linguistics** at the 47th Austrian Linguistics Symposium, which will take place on **December 8th, 2023** at University of Graz. The section Clinical Linguistics aims to provide a forum for researchers, practitioners, and students interested in the intersection between linguistics and clinical practice.

We welcome submissions on topics including, but not limited to:

- (Developmental) language disorders, their assessment and treatment/therapy approaches
- Multilingualism and multilingual language development in clinical contexts
- Social communication
- Digitalization during childhood in connection with language development
- Neurolinguistics and the study of language and the brain
- Language and communication in specific populations (e.g., autism, dementia)
- Clinical applications of linguistic theory and analysis

We welcome empirical and theoretical contributions as well as implementations in clinical practice from a variety of disciplines, including linguistics, psychology, speech and language therapy, and education.

Submissions may take the form of individual papers. Individual papers will be allotted 20 minutes for presentation and 5 minutes for discussion.

Submission guidelines:

- Abstracts should be 200-400 words and follow the structure background, aims, methods, results and conclusion
- Submissions should include a title, author names and affiliations, and a list of references
- Submissions should be sent to antonia.pock@bblinz.at until **September 30th, 2023**
- Acceptance notifications will be sent out by **October 15th, 2023**
- Participants are asked to sign up to ÖLT independently from the section Clinical Linguistics (<https://sprachwissenschaft.uni-graz.at/de/forschen/oelt-2023/allgemeine-informationen/>)
