Collaboration between students from different departments are also highly appreciated.

In case you do not want to demonstrate your own empirical work that you conducted as part of a course or for your thesis, you can also present some program/tool you worked with during your studies or are still working with. To make such presentations as beneficial as possible for your fellow participants, we invite you to structure it in a way that others can make their first steps within the program/tool as you show them how it works. For example, if you have worked with PRAAT and want to make your contribution about it, make sure to also provide us with a sound file that everyone can use to try PRAAT themselves.

Time slots for each contribution are 30 minutes (20 minutes presentation in German or English + 10 minutes discussion)
