- Language use in corona discourses (objectivity vs. realization and provocation of emotionality)
- Modalities of conveying information in corona discourses
- Regional, national and international similarities and differences in corona discourses
- Intercultural and interlingual similarities and differences in corona discourses
- Intermediality and intertextuality in corona discourses
- Multimediality in corona discourses.
