ÖLT 2023

CALL FOR PAPERS: Current Issues in Syntax, Semantics, and Pragmatics

(English version) We are pleased to announce the workshop *Current Issues in Syntax, Semantics, and Pragmatics*, to be held at the ÖLT 2023 in Graz (December 8-10). This workshop aims to create opportunities for researchers to discuss their original, unpublished work related to any of the fields mentioned in the title as well as at the interfaces. We invite submissions for presentations (20mins talk+10mins discussion) of theoretical and/or empirical contributions investigating the syntax, semantics, or pragmatics of linguistic phenomena. The workshop is not confined to a particular topic or researched language, and we wish to also encourage researchers who prospect yet undertheorized natural language phenomena to apply.

Abstracts should not exceed two A4 pages with 1inch (2.54cm) margins on all sides, with an additional third page for references, and large figures or tables. Font must be set in Times New Roman with a font size no smaller than 12pt. Examples (no matter whether glossed or not) should be interspersed in the text, rather than collected at the end. Submissions must be anonymous and must not reveal the identities of the authors in any way. At most two submissions per (co-)author are allowed, only one may be single-authored.
