The presentation will introduce the inter- and transdisciplinary FWF-funded project "Art Experience in the (Post-) Digital Age { original | digital | virtual }". It aims to describe, to analyze, and to differentiate the particular perceptual qualities of original artworks, their digital surrogates, as well as digital expansions into the virtual space (augmented and virtual reality). We investigate whether the presentation medium of visual art makes a difference, based on four empirical

comparative studies at the Austrian Gallery Belvedere in Vienna. By using a mixed-methods approach with qualitative interviews, mobile eye-tracking and questionnaires, we successfully collected data from over 50 participants (museum visitors) for each of the four conditions. The talk will present the next steps regarding data processing as well as initial findings.
