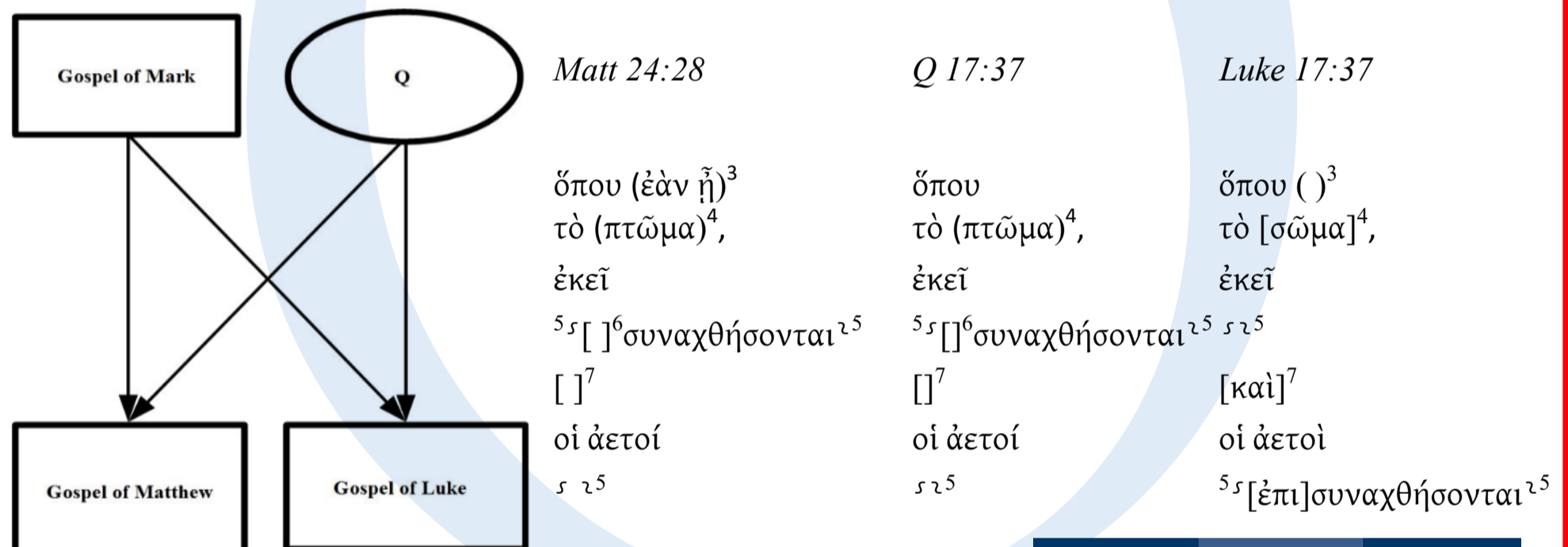

According to the widely accepted Two Source Theory, the hypothetical Sayings Gospel Q is the second source of the Gospels of Matthew and Luke. As a collection of sayings of Jesus, situated within a partly biographical context, the Sayings Gospel Q originated in a very early independent branch of Jewish Christian tradition and is of immense importance for the reconstruction of the historical Jesus.
