Ukrainian Scholars at Risk Fellowship "Theology & Religion"

In light of the Russian Invasion of Ukraine and the threat posed by the war to all civilians, including academics, the Faculty of Catholic Theology at the University of Graz has decided to offer a fellowship for academics from Ukraine to spend one semester (4 months) in Graz to conduct, present their research and collaborate with other researchers.

The *Ukrainian Scholars at Risk Fellowship "Theology & Religion"* aims to provide a Ukrainian academic currently under threat due to the Russian Invasion with an interim academic and allow them to continue their work in a safe environment for themselves and their families. The fellowship is open for researchers from a wide range of academic backgrounds focusing their research on themes around theology and religion.

The Visiting Fellow will receive a monthly stipend of 1250 € for the duration of 4 months (March - June 2022) and travel costs to Graz (of up to 500 €). The Visiting Fellow will be provided with a workspace, library access and will be able to participate in the activities of the Faculty of Theology as well as other institutions within the university relevant to their research subject.

The university will cover liability and accident insurance; health insurance needs to be covered by fellow. The Fellowship does not constitute an employment by the University of Graz.

The fellowship is open to Ukrainian citizens or academics who were resident in Ukraine at the time of the invasion or are directly affected by the war. Applications should include a CV and a motivation letter. The fellowship can be taken up *immediately* after being awarded.
