He supports the development and implementation of PGR training, including delivery of the weekly GPS Webinar Series on research skills for PhD candidates. Recently, as part of a consortium of eight universities, he led the UL bid for funding under the Horizon Europe Call, ‘Developing an effective ERA talent pipeline,’ which secured a total of over €1.5 million to enhance PhD employability by improving transferable skills training and developing local talent management centres.
