

Information sheet for lecturers of the BioTechMed-Graz PhD Program

The BioTechMed-Graz PhD Program aims at establishing a closer link between the existing doctoral programs of the 3 universities - Uni Graz, Med Uni Graz and TU Graz.

Integration of courses

Thematically, all courses are suitable that can be assigned to the research areas of BioTechMed-Graz or that are considered as additional qualifications (e.g. presentation skills or scientific writing).

If you would like to include a course in the PhD program, please send a short description of your planned course to office@biotechmedgraz.at. After the approval by the board of directors the course can be included in the BioTechMed-Graz PhD Program.

Course organization

The course organization is based on the guidelines of the university at which the course is held and is also managed as an explicit teaching offer of the universities (no external offer/workshop). The respective course is reflected in the online course offer of all 3 universities.

Compensation

The courses of the BioTechMed-Graz PhD program and their compensation are based on the number of semester hours per week according to the guidelines of the university where the teaching takes place.

All employees who have a contract of employment at one of the three universities and whose employment includes teaching do not receive any additional compensation and are paid according to their contract of employment. External teachers, i.e. not employees of the 3 BioTechMed-Graz partner universities, and persons without integrated teaching in their employment contract receive an (external) teaching assignment according to the collective agreement. The teaching remuneration is paid according to the respective service law (collective agreement, federal civil servants, etc.).

Grading/evaluation

All lecturers receive an assignment from the respective BioTechMed-Graz partner university. The grading or evaluation is to be carried out by the lecturers themselves via the respective online examination management, depending on the requirements of the university.









Crediting

The courses of the BioTechMed-Graz PhD program are open to all PhD students of the BioTechMed-Graz related PhD programs. Crediting of a course of the BioTechMed-Graz PhD Program is generally offered as an elective subject in consultation with the responsible curriculum committee.

The prerequisite for all PhD students is to register as a co-registered student at the university where the course is held. Information on co-registration at the partner universities can be found here:
