Ten Years of International PhD Program at the Medical University of Graz

he first international PhD program at the Medical University of Graz, focused on 'Molecular Medicine', was launched in 2007. This PhD program was subsequently joined by two Doctoral Colleges focused on 'Metabolic and Cardiovascular Disease' and 'Molecular Fundamentals of Inflammation' and two further PhD programs devoted to 'Brain Aging' and 'Advanced Medical Biomarker Research'. In all of these programs the new European standards of doctoral education have been implemented: competitive selection of graduate students, dissertation agreement with a thesis committee, employment of students, structured curricula offered by the program's faculty, training in all aspects of a research career, international networking, regular monitoring of each student's progress, education of supervisors, and independent peer review of thesis and thesis defense. These achievements have been recognized by national and international accreditations of the PhD Studies.

The PhD programs at the Medical University of Graz provide a stimulating environment in which the graduate students are educated to become independent researchers and to pursue a science-directed career at an internationally competitive level. The success of the PhD Studies has been amply proved by the postdoctoral careers of the alumni and the substantial contribution of the students' publications to the university's research output.
