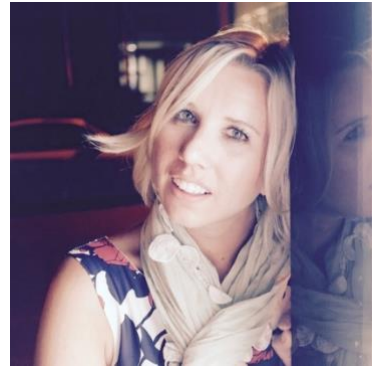




Silvia Schultermandl is an associate professor of American Studies. She grew up singing misheard lyrics to 1980s US pop songs.
