PostDoc Peer Mentoring Team 2023: Call for Participants & Application Form

Peer mentoring means that a group of postdoctoral researchers work together as a closed group for a year to enhance their professional development. It is based on the assumption that each of the group members has an advantage of knowledge, competence and experience in a specific domain that they can make accessible to the others. The PostDoc Peer Mentoring Team is intended for persons interested in receiving and giving support to/from peers outside their immediate work area

- on career steps (within or outside academia)
- on work- & life-balance related topics

The PostDoc Peer Mentoring Team consists of up to 15 participants. It is interdisciplinary, mixed-gender, and lasts from spring 2023 until spring 2024. The programme is supported by the PostDoc Office, additional knowledge & training will be provided by career experts and professional coaches.

Target group

The target group are postdoctoral researchers who are employed in temporary contracts at the University of Graz at the time of application. Participants commit to stay with the Peer Mentoring Team for one year. The working language is determined within the group.
