Incoming Mobility for Short Research Stays

(Two weeks to Three months)

The [Arqus European University Alliance](#) brings together the [University of Bergen](#), the [University of Granada](#), the [University of Graz](#), the [University of Leipzig](#), the [University of Padua](#), [Vilnius University](#), the Université Lyon 1, the Université Lyon 3 and the Université de Saint-Étienne, all longstanding comprehensive research universities.

PURPOSE OF THE CALL – INCOMING MOBILITIES

Thanks to a funding of the *Agence Nationale de la Recherche* (ANR) and of the Arqus programme, this call will facilitate the hosting in Lyon – Saint-Étienne of **researchers/postdocs/doctoral candidates** from one of the Arqus partner universities for short research stays.

The involvement of researchers from at least two Arqus partners is imperative, as the collaborative aspect is a key feature of the scheme.

The research stay must be carried out until 30 September 2022.

ELIGIBILITY

- Researchers, postdocs and doctoral candidates from all fields of research are eligible, as long as they are attached to a laboratory hosted by one of the Arqus partner universities.

Locally, the research stay must be planned with collaborators hosted in a laboratory/research unit under the main supervision of the Université Lyon 1 or Université Lyon 3 or Université de Saint-Étienne.

FUNDING

The flat-rate funding of €1000/month for the research stay (prorated where necessary) is intended to contribute to the research costs and will be paid to the host laboratory.

Research stay from **two weeks to three months** can be funded.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- The call is open until 15 April 2022.
- Please email a scan of your signed application, with the required attachments, to romain.thinon@univ-lyon1.fr & anne.giroir-fendler@ircelyon.univ-lyon1.fr
- Applications will be received and processed on a rolling basis. A rapid response will be given.

The selection board will reserve the right to evaluate the number of participants and the duration of the research stay according to the budget available.

The selection of applicants is based on the following criteria:

- ✓ The involvement of researchers/supervisors from at least two Arqus partners is imperative
- ✓ Quality of the proposal, aims and objectives
- ✓ Joint research interest in the proposed topic
- ✓ Research area with substantial overlap between the two universities
