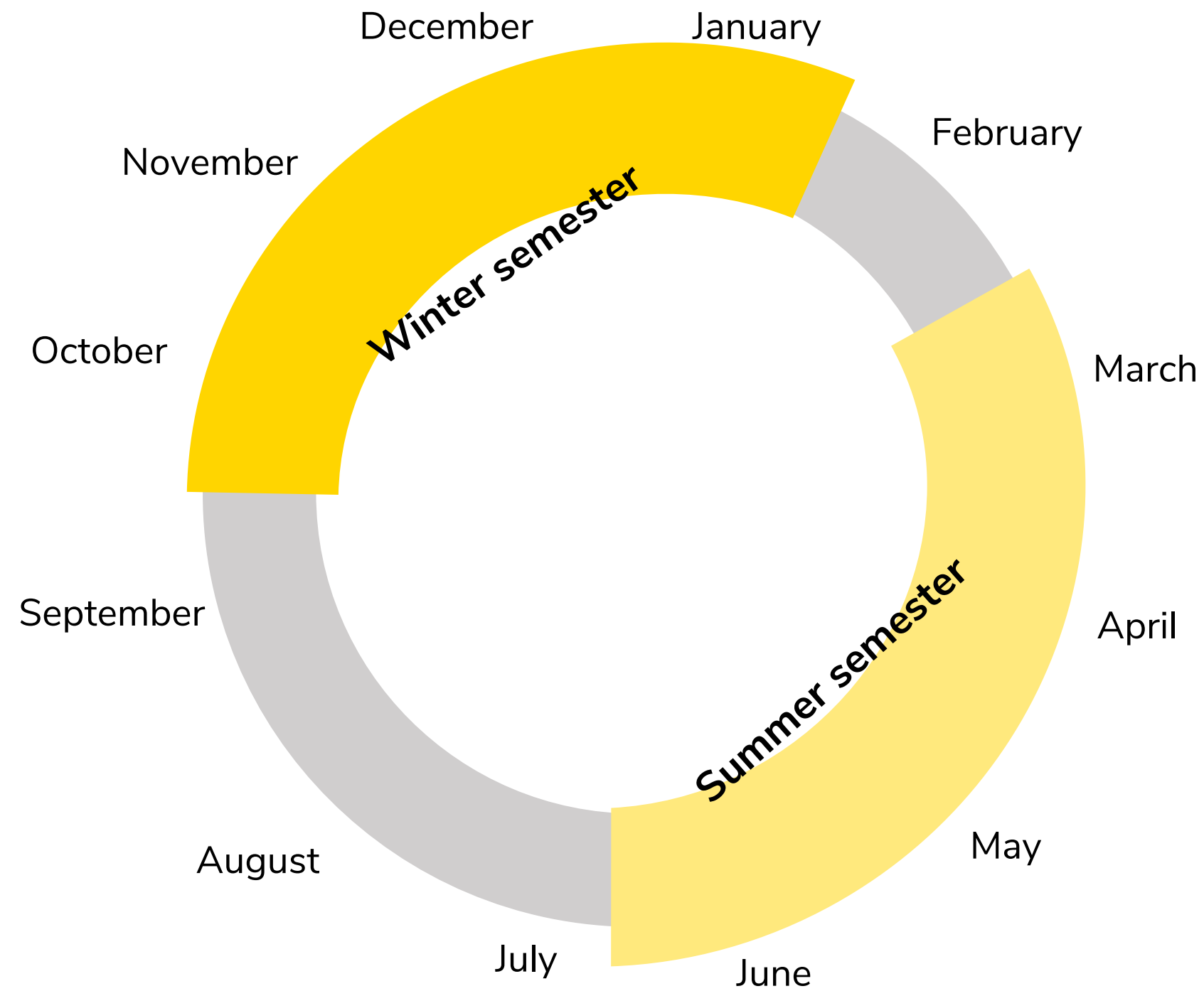

Offers for Ukrainian (prospective) students

General information



- Tuition fee waiver for the winter semester 2022/2023
- Student union fee = € 21.20 per semester
if your financial situation does not allow payment, it will be covered by the student's union (ÖH)
- Ernst Mach Scholarship Ukraine
 - only for students who are pursuing or preparing to pursue a bachelor/diploma/master degree in Austria
 - € 715 per month
- Housing opportunities: dorms around campus or in Graz, rental costs vary

Residence status

Ukrainians are eligible for the residence card for displaced persons



Karte für Vertriebene

- Special status until at least March 2023 (extension likely)
- Working & studying is possible, only a few restrictions at the Austrian labor market
- No financial requirements are linked to this status
- Insurance & basic care

Residence permit „student“

- Restricted access to the labor market, max. 20 working hours / week
- Minimum financial means per month for a year in advance:
 - < 24 y.o. € 569,11 (= 6.829,32)
 - > 24 y.o. € 1.030,49 (= 12.365,88)
- Personal documents (legalized, translated), insurance, housing, student documents required for the application

Study options



Enrolment for selected classes

1. You do not obtain a degree from Uni Graz
2. You can sign up for classes from the course offer (you choose yourself)
3. Easy access, only ID required
4. Access to library, German classes, sports classes,...

Regular study programmes

1. Bachelor's, Master's, Diploma, PhD/doctoral degree
2. You have to apply as international student at the Academic Affairs
3. Entrance exam may be required for some study programmes (e.g. psychology, biology, pharmaceutical sciences,...)
4. Language requirements: all bachelor programmes require German skills

Application Process for Ukrainian Students

First steps:

Read all available information

Ask if something is unclear

Try to meet the deadlines

Requirements for Admission to a Bachelor- or Diploma Programme



- ✓ Filled out Application Form
- ✓ Copy of a valid Identification Card or Passport
- ✓ CV
- ✓ Evidence of general qualification for university entrance
- ✓ Language certificate
- ✓ (for NAWI Graz Study programmes: Beilage zum Zulassungsantrag für das NAWI Graz Studium)



! as **originals** or as **notarised copies**

! If the original document has not been issued in English or German, a **translation** into German or English is mandatory (by a sworn translator)

! Applicants who have the **status refugee or seeking asylum** in Austria can be exempted from the **legalisation** due to the political circumstances.

Study offer per language



German study programmes

- ALL bachelor level programmes require German skills
- A2 level minimum to apply, C1 level to start programme
- Certificates/proofs: mandatory, see website of Academic Affairs. Certificates must not be older than 2 years

English study programmes

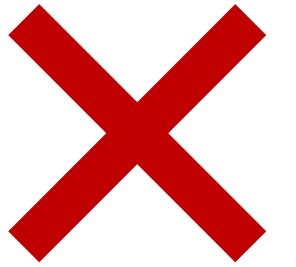
- NO bachelor level programmes
- Selected master's & PhD programmes
→ see list on Academic Affairs website
- Certificates/proofs: mandatory, see website of Academic Affairs. Certificates must not be older than 2 years!

Programmes offered in German



You have **no** prior German skills or a certificate that is older than 2 years, or one that's not on the list.

You cannot apply for a study programme yet. At first, you should learn German privately and take a certificate of at least level A2. Note that not any German certificate is accepted, check the list on the website of the Academic Affairs.



You have at least A2 German skills but less than C1.

You can apply for a study programme, if you have a language certificate or confirmation not older than 2 years. If you fulfill all other requirements for studying, you can participate in the university preparation programme to improve your German up to level C1.



C1 German skills or higher

You can apply for a study programme, if you have a language certificate or confirmation that fulfills the requirements. If you fulfill all other requirements too, you can be admitted to studies.



Programmes offered in English



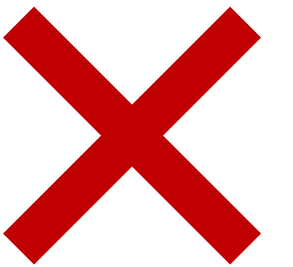
You do not have one of the certificates / proofs

You have a certificate, but it's older than 2 years or has a lower score.

You have a certificate/proof that fulfills the requirements.

You cannot apply for a study programme offered in English yet. At first, you should get one of the certificates mentioned on the website of the Academic Affairs. Also make sure to check the minimum scores per certificate.

You can apply for a study programme offered in English, if you have a language certificate or confirmation that fulfills the requirements. If you are admitted, you can start your studies.

University preparation programme

Vorstudienlehrgang



- You have to be accepted by the university first - you need the letter of admission to sign up
- Costs ~ 500€ per semester, but no tuition fee at university additionally
- University will tell you which exams you have to pass at the UPP in the letter of admission

Deadlines

for admission

- > for the winter semester until **September 5th**
- > for the summer semester until **February 5th**

for restricted study programmes in case you already have C1 or good German skills

- > For the next winter and summer semester only few vacant spots left
e.g. teaching program until 12 August
e.g. law, business administration, economics etc. until spots are filled
