The SOG18 conference »**The beginning of the secularisation in Europe's Southeast**« will be held on 30<sup>th</sup> of May – 2<sup>d</sup> of June 2024 in the Seminar Hotel Retzhof (near Leibnitz, Southern Austria). The next International Congress of the International Society for Eighteenth Century Studies (ISECS) with the title »**Enlightenment and Equality**« will be held in Zaragoza (Spain) in July 2027.
