Dear PhD students,

we are happy to announce the **5th ÖGP JuWis Summerschool** and the **2nd Writing Retreat** taking place from **15-17 July 2019** in Spital am Pyhrn.

During the **Summerschool**, PhDs get the opportunity to...

- ... present and discuss their own dissertation projects in small groups supervised by scientific experts.
- ... receive input on topics relevant to their dissertation projects (keynotes).
- ... work on their presentation skills.
- ... get to know PhDs, postdocs, and professors from Universities all across Austria (networking).

During the **Writing Retreat**, PhDs and Postdocs get the opportunity to...



- ... work on their articles in a quiet atmosphere.
- ... attend the workshops and keynotes of the Summerschool.
- ... get to know PhDs, postdocs, and professors from Universities all across Austria (networking).

The Summerschool and the Writing Retreat are two independent programs that take place simultaneously, but have different aims and different agendas. The Summerschool is mainly interesting for PhDs that stand rather at the beginning of their journeys and can serve as a first step into the wider academic world, giving opportunity to develop ones dissertation project, learn and connect. The Writing Retreat aims at advanced PhDs and Postdocs that are focused on publication of their research and are given the opportunity to progress their articles, papers or books in a continuous and concentrated way. Each participant can sign up for only one of the two programs, however participants of the Writing Retreat are also free to participate at the keynotes and workshops offered in the Summerschool program.

The Summerschool and Writing Retreat are organized by the young scientists of the ÖGP (ÖGP-JUWIS-VertreterInnen), who represent all Austrian Universities that offer a PhD study in Psychology.

Please register for the **5th ÖGP JuWis Summerschool** or the **2nd Writing Retreat** by sending an informal e-mail to oeppjuwis@gmail.com stating whether you would like to participate at the Summerschool or the Writing Retreat. Following this, you will receive further information.

An application to the Summerschool should include the following:

- An abstract outlining the specific part of dissertation topic which shall be addressed at the Summerschool (**max.** 1 page)

To participate in the Writing Retreat no abstract is needed.

Registration is open until Monday, June 10th, 2019.

Preparation for attending the Summerschool:

As can be seen in the program, all PhDs will have an active role to play as part of the Summerschool. Each PhD will be asked to present the own dissertation topic in small groups supervised by scientific experts in their respective fields. The presentation should enable the audience to grasp the theoretical rationales, aims, and problems to be anticipated in the respective dissertation topic. To fulfil this aim, the presentation should also include the underlying research literature; first results – even if only preliminary – are most welcome. To maximize the potential benefits of the exchange within the small group supervised by scientific experts, the presentation should also include questions to be discussed within the group, and critically reflect the own dissertation topic, planning, and progress. The presentation should be media-supported (e.g. power point presentation) and be 10-15 minutes.

Preparation for attending the Writing Retreat:

PhDs and Postdocs will follow a systematic writing schedule separated into writing slots and breaks through the morning and in the afternoon in separate rooms, where they will be continuously working on writing one max. two articles (papers, book chapters) in order to reach their set goals. Thus, participants of the Writing Retreat ought to choose and prepare a “manuscript in progress” that will be in the main writing focus and formulate a more or less detailed document outlining the writing goals they wish to reach in each writing session, day or at the end of the retreat. The fulfilment of the goals will be reassessed at the end of the retreat.
