Born 1958 in Vienna, law studies at Vienna (Dr. iur. 1980) and Cambridge (England; LL.M. 1982), 1980 - 1983 research assistant at the Institute of Public Law of Vienna University.

Since 1983 Austrian Federal Ministry for Foreign Affairs (now Federal Ministry for European and International Affairs), while in Austria always attached to the Office of the Legal Adviser ("Völkerrechtsbüro") of that ministry. Postings abroad in Belgrade (1984), Geneva (1985 - 1988) and Brussels (1993 - 2000), 1988 -1990 deputy head of the Vienna Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR). 2000 - 2009 head of the "General International Law" unit of the Office of the Legal Adviser, 2007 - 2009 deputy legal adviser, since 2010 legal adviser of the ministry.

Professor at Graz University, lecturer at the Diplomatic Academy in Vienna. Various publications, in particular – since 2011 annually, together with colleagues from the Office of the Legal Adviser – „Recent Austrian practice in the field of international law“ in the Zeitschrift für Öffentliches Recht (ZÖR).
