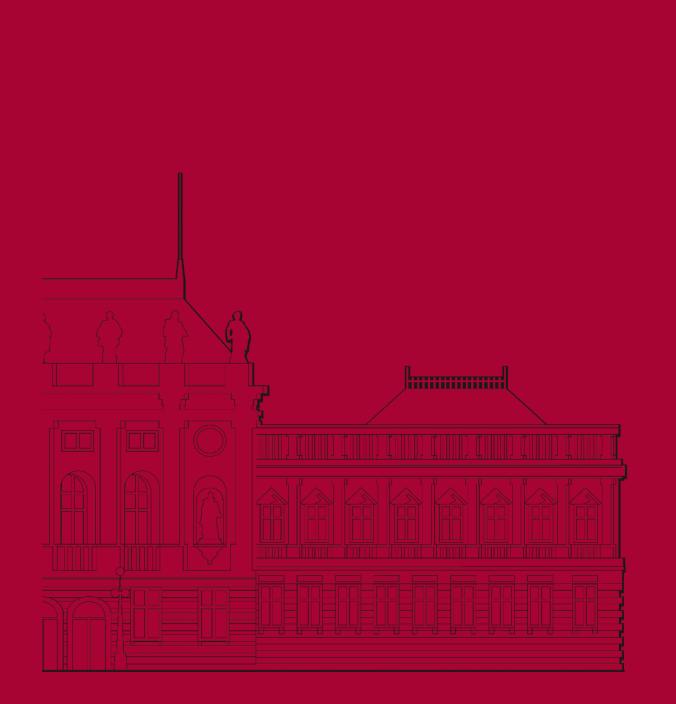


Author Guidelines for the Graz Law Working Paper Series



Publishing a Working Paper with the Graz Law Working Paper Series

The *Graz Law Working Paper Series* focuses on legal scholarship in all subject areas, including public law, private law as well as comparative law and interdisciplinary research. All faculty members of the Graz Law Faculty (Rewi Graz), its doctoral students and visiting scholars are invited to submit working papers to the series. Research reports from one of the Faculty's many projects can also be submitted, as can papers presented at academic conferences hosted at Rewi Graz. Papers may be submitted in English or German, and can follow any consistent style of citation. The series contains working papers, ie pre-prints that have not yet been published in a journal or edited volume. The papers are published electronically and are freely available online. The series is hosted on SSRN.

Instructions for Authors

Papers should be submitted in Microsoft Word format to law.wps@uni-graz.at. We recommend the use of our templates.

In your submission, please include:

- Name and contact information
- Short biography (max. 100 words)
- A picture for the biography (optional)
- Abstract (max. 250 words)
- Keywords (up to 8)

Please submit a signed copy of the <u>licence agreement</u> with your paper, and see our <u>data protection declaration</u>. The paper cannot be published before the licence agreement is received.

Working with our templates

Step-by-step guide:

- Download the template <u>here</u>
 - o Choose between the English / German version
 - Choose between <u>one author</u> / <u>two authors</u> version
- Open the Microsoft Word template
- Fill in the yellow boxes

0	Paper title	→ page I
0	Author1 first name / Author 1 last name	→ page I
0	Author2 first name / Author 2 last name	→ page I
0	Abstract (max. 250 words)	→ page III
0	Keywords (max. 8 words)	→ page III
0	Biography1 (optional: insert a portrait)	→ page III
0	Biography2 (optional: insert a portrait)	→ page III

- Start writing your paper on page 1
- Citation: The paper can follow any consistent style of citation
