

Criteria for admission to the Master's program
Political and Empirical Economics
at Karl Franzens University of Graz
(as of 13 March 2019)

*(This translation only serves as information. Legally relevant is the German version
as of 13 March 2019)*

Pursuant to § 64 para. 3, Universitätsgesetz 2002 admission to a master's program is only granted to persons holding an equivalent bachelor degree in a field relevant to the master's program in *Political and Empirical Economics*. Equivalence is assumed to be given if the acquired skills from a previous study are sufficient to study the master's program *Political and Empirical Economics* at Graz University within an appropriate period of time.

- 1) An equivalent degree that is suitable for the subject is only present if **at least 40 ECTS credits** in Economics, Mathematics, Statistics or Econometrics have been passed during the previous studies.
- 2) Given a fully equivalent previous degree, an **approval without conditions** is possible. This is the case if the following courses or modules of the undergraduate curriculum *Economics* (Version 17W) or equivalent courses/modules have been successfully completed:

In the admission process missing courses/modules will be prescribed as **mandatory additional courses**, whereby only requirements of a maximum of 30 ECTS are possible. For requirements > 30 ECTS no approval can be granted!
