**Production and reproduction of academic elites in Argentina.
Publication styles, linguistic capacities and circuits of academic recognition.**

Zum Vortrag:

The research capacities of Argentina have grown astronomically in these recent years. The scientific field is dynamic, predominantly public and the number of full-time researchers has quadrupled in the past decade. At the same time, however, the scientific-university field is more heterogeneous and there is a greater distance between scientists who have adopted the dominant production styles in the world scientific system and those who have a more local agenda and only publish in Spanish. In order to gain a deeper understanding of these profiles, this work focuses on the most internationalized sector of the academic community of Argentina: the National Scientific and Technical Research Council (CONICET). In this study a database was built which allows observing the circuits of the journals, the countries where these productions are published and the different profiles that appear when examining each scientific discipline.

Zur Vortragenden:

Fernanda Beigel is a sociologist and PhD in Social Sciences (2001). She is Independent Researcher at CONICET, Head Professor of the Latin American Sociology chair and Director of the PhD Program of Political and Social Sciences at the National University of Cuyo (Mendoza, Argentina). Currently Fernanda Beigel leads the research program on Academic Dependency in Latin America (PIDAAL), a research team composed of 17 young fellows and researchers from CONICET and the UNCuyo.
