### Requirements

- WLAN-enabled device e.g. notebook or smartphone




#### Note for "Outgoings" of Graz University:

## **Connect "eduroam" network**

- 1. On the *Home screen*, in the *taskbar*, click the *Network Settings* icon.
- 2. Select the network **eduroam** and click on *Connect*. If you want to connect to the network automatically in the future, check Automatically connect.







- 3. Enter your *login data* in the following format and click OK.
  - Username: Your Uni Graz e-mail address
  - Password: Your current UNIGRAZonline password

- 4. You will then be asked if you want to *connect* eduroam. Click *Connect* again to complete the setup.
